

Piano Keys



The Black Keys:

Sha<u>r</u>ps go to the <u>R</u>ight of the note. F# is the black key to the right of the F key.

F<u>l</u>ats go to the <u>L</u>eft of the note. E_b is the black key to the left of the E key.



Each black key has two names – it can be either sharp or flat. The rightmost black note in this diagram (*) can be A# or Bb.
