

Ranges - Pitched Percussion

Crotales		sounds one octave higher
Tubular Bells (Chimes)		non-transposing
Glockenspiel		sounds two octaves higher
Xylophone		Sounds one octave higher. Xylophones vary in size and can have more octaves up or down. The xylo usually starts on F or C, but can sometimes start on A or G.
Marimba		non-transposing
Vibraphone		non-transposing Like the xylophone, vibes sometimes go up to seven octaves.
Timpani		Timps are played in sets of 2-5. Each drum has the range of a 5th, with some overlap between each drum.
